For the control of short sight

Orthokeratology, or “Ortho-k” allows patients with short sight (myopia) to see clearly without glasses or daytime contact lenses.

The procedure involves individually-designed contact lenses, worn overnight, which gently reshape the cornea.

How The Ortho- K Lens Works



This process is great for adults who don't want to wear contacts or specs during the day, and it's PARTICULARLY good for children.

Why children? Because ortho-k **stops the short sight from becoming worse** over time as well.
